Retail workers suffer shocking violence and abuse every day at work.

Usdaw has successfully campaigned for a new law in Scotland, making it a specific offence to abuse, threaten or assault retail workers. The Protection of Workers Bill (Scotland) was passed by the Scottish Parliament earlier this year. From 24 August, a new groundbreaking law will come into effect.

Usdaw is campaigning for all retail workers across England, Wales and Northern Ireland to have this additional protection.

Unreported retail crime deprives the victims of justice and can skew crime figures to mask the true scale of the problem. Make sure you report any incidents of violence or abuse that happen to you or a colleague to your employer, the police and your Usdaw rep.
