Usdaw can provide help and support when problems arise at work. By joining Usdaw you will get access to professional trade union advice and support.



# MANY GOOD REASONS TO JOIN USDAW



### **BETTER PAY**

Usdaw negotiates pay on behalf of hundreds of thousands of workers and getting the best possible deal is our number one aim. On average, trade union members receive more pay per hour than non-members. Usdaw wants to win negotiating rights for workers at Aldi.

### **BETTER CONDITIONS**

Trade union organised workplaces tend to have better holiday entitlement, improved pension provision and arrangements for time off work. Negotiations aren't just about pay, Usdaw aims to improve the other things that matter at work such as holidays, pensions, shift arrangements, etc.

### SAFER WORKPLACE

You are twice as likely to have an accident at a workplace where there isn't a union. Usdaw makes sure that your safety at work is taken seriously and our reps are trained to spot potential hazards and to get things changed at work.

### **LEGAL & ACCIDENT COVER**

Usdaw's legal service wins millions in compensation each year for members. As an Usdaw member the legal service is entirely free – you don't pay a penny. No one plans to have an accident but if you do, Usdaw will help you with your claim for compensation for any accident, anywhere. Usdaw will also provide you with free legal advice on any issue.

### **ADVICE & SUPPORT**

Our highly trained Union Officials are available to advise and support members at work as and when you need it. The Union employs specialists in pensions, health and safety, and employment law to support and help members.

### **PROTECTION AT WORK**

Union members are half as likely to be sacked as non-members. By ensuring that members have strong and effective advice and support, Usdaw is able to protect people at work and resolve issues before they become major problems.

### **FAIRNESS AT WORK**

Union workplaces are fairer workplaces and are much more likely to have family friendly policies. By negotiating with employers, Usdaw is able to secure better deals on issues such as career opportunities, flexible working arrangements and general support for family responsibilities.
