**Six good reasons why you should join Usdaw
– your trade union.**

Six good reasons why you should join Usdaw...

❶ We help our members find out about their rights at work.

For instance, did you know that you have a right to:

- A minimum wage for adults. This goes up every year and since 1 April 2022 has been:
£9.50 an hour for aged 23 and over
£9.18 an hour for aged 21-22
£6.83 an hour for aged 18-20
£4.81 an hour for aged 16-17
- 28 days' paid holiday a year (for someone working 5 days a week).
- 11 hours' daily rest.
- Most workers are entitled to sick pay after three days' sickness.

❷ We take up our members' problems with management and represent you at disciplinary hearings.

❸ We give our members FREE legal advice and representation in the event of an accident at work, unfair dismissal and discrimination.

❹ We can help our members access FREE training on a wide range of topics including English, Maths and computer skills.

❺ We campaign against racism and promote equal treatment for all workers.

❻ We work to improve our members' pay and life at work.

- Everyone can join a trade union.
- You have a legal right to join a trade union.
- You do not have to tell your employer that you are a member of a trade union.
- It is unlawful for anyone to discriminate against you for being a trade union member.
